Academic warning, probation, and suspension holds are placed after the grading period at the end of each semester. Students whose cumulative GPA and completion rate meet the minimum standards are considered in "good standing".

- A. Academic Warning:** Students who are in good standing at the beginning of the term but fall below the minimum cumulative GPA or cumulative completion rate at the end of the term will be placed on academic warning. Students on academic warning will be allowed to enroll for the next full semester, or summer sessions. Students on Academic Warning are required to complete an Academic Success Plan with the Graduate Studies Department. There may be additional requirements which will be emailed to the student.
- B. Academic Suspension:** Students who do not meet the GPA and/or percent completion criteria required of their Warning or Probation status will be suspended. An Academic Suspension hold, which prevents registration, will be placed on the student's record at the end of the semester. Students who are suspended for the first time may not return to MSUM for one semester. Second and subsequent suspensions last for one calendar year (two semesters, not including summer).

I understand and agree to the requirements listed above. I also understand that if I fail to complete the student success plan satisfactorily, I could be terminated from the degree program.
